

PM Spring Sports Construction-Related Transportation Changes

Due to the high school construction project, student parking will be restricted on the high school campus, resulting in changes to athletics transportation.

Effective Monday March 18, students will park at Comet Field and be shuttled to the high school for the school day. Shuttles will run from the high school back to Comet Field at the conclusion of the school day for car pick-up. Athletes then will attend practice at Comet Field or will drive their cars back to the high school campus (track & field and boys' volleyball) or to Manor Middle School (boys' tennis and girls' softball) to attend their practices or home competitions.

ALL athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. daily to board athletic shuttle buses to Comet Field and/or report directly to their practice sites (if they are a non-driver participating in track & field or boys' volleyball).

Shuttle busses will be picking up ALL athletes that are student drivers at the "Shuttle Lane" (located between the bus lane and flagpole; administration will be present to assist) at 2:35 p.m. daily. This will be an excused early release that will be communicated to the HS staff by the athletic office and administration.

Coaches, please inform your athletes that, after school, they will need to relocate their vehicles away from the lower level of parking at Comet Field, by the stadium, to leave this area clear for officials, game day staff and patrons attending events.

The following is a breakdown of how the transportation changes affect each program for week day/school day schedules.

Girls Lacrosse:

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Student Drivers & Non-Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed at 2:35 p.m. to board the shuttle to Comet Field at the "Shuttle Lane."

Away Contest Transportation (All) – Athletes will be picked up at the back side of the cafeteria doors (lower level, by bus lane) by the team bus, which will then stop at Comet Field to load game day needs and then head to the away contest. After the away contest concludes, the team bus will return to Comet Field for drop off and pick up.

**Note – Night and weekend contests will not require an early release from class, and all buses will pick up and drop off up at Comet Field*

Boys Lacrosse:

**Note – Boys' Lax practice at Comet Field is 6-8 p.m. daily and will not require early release. Student drivers will still be released at 2:35 p.m. and should take the shuttle bus to Comet Field to retrieve their automobiles.*

Home Contest Transportation (Student Drivers & Non-Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. to board the shuttle to Comet Field at the "Shuttle Lane."

Away Contest Transportation (All) – Athletes will be picked up at the back side of the cafeteria doors (lower level by bus lane) by the team bus, which will stop at Comet Field to load game day needs and then head to the away contest. After the away contest concludes, the team bus will return to Comet Field for drop off and pick up.

**Note – Night and weekend contests will not require early release from class, and all buses will pick up and drop off up at Comet Field.*

Baseball:

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Student Drivers & Non-Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. to board the shuttle to Comet Field at the “Shuttle Lane.”

Away Contest Transportation (All) – Athletes will be picked up at the back side of the cafeteria doors (lower level by bus lane) by the team bus, which will stop at Comet Field to load game day needs and then head to the away contest. After the away contest concludes, the team bus will return to Comet Field for drop off and pick up.

**Note – Night and weekend contests will not require early release from class, and all buses will pick up and drop off up at Comet Field.*

Softball:

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. to board the shuttle to Comet Field at the “Shuttle Lane” and then drive to Manor Middle School.

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Non-Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. and be picked up in front of the flagpole by the Shuttle Bus, which will transport them to Manor Middle School.

Away Contest Transportation (All) – Athletes will be picked up at the back side of the cafeteria doors (lower level by bus lane) by the team bus, which will stop at Comet Field to load game day needs and then head to the away contest. After the away contest concludes, the team bus will return to Comet Field for drop off and pick up.

Boys' Tennis:

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. to board the shuttle to Comet Field at the “Shuttle Lane” and then drive to Manor Middle School.

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Non-Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. and be picked up in front of the flagpole by the Shuttle Bus, which will transport them to Manor Middle School.

Away Contest Transportation (All) – Athletes will be picked up at the back side of the cafeteria doors (lower level by bus lane) by the team bus, which will stop at Comet Field to load game day needs and then head to the away contest. After the away contest concludes, the team bus will return to Comet Field for drop off and pick up.

Track & Field:

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. to board the shuttle to Comet Field at the “Shuttle Lane” and then drive back to the high school campus for practice (parking will be available at the bus lot ONLY, and athletes will need to walk to the track from there).

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Non-Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. and report directly to the locker rooms and then to the track or designated location set by the coaching staff.

Away Contest Transportation (All) – Athletes will be picked up at the West Gym by team buses and then head to the away contest. After the away contest concludes, the team bus will make one stop at Comet Field for student drivers to get their vehicles, and then head to the high school for drop-off and pick-up.

**Note – Middle School shuttles from Marticville and Manor will drop off athletes at the flagpole. Athletes will be met by a member of the Junior High Track & Field coaching staff, who will walk them through the high school to the locker rooms and eventually out to the practice area.*

Boys' Volleyball:

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. to board the shuttle to Comet Field at the “Shuttle Lane” and then drive back to the high school campus for practice (parking will be available at the bus lot ONLY, and athletes will need to walk up through the cafeteria to the East Gym).

Practice and Home Contest Transportation (Non-Student Drivers) – Athletes will be dismissed from class at 2:35 p.m. and report directly to the locker rooms and then to the East Gym or designated location set by the coaching staff.

Away Contest Transportation (All) – Athletes will be picked up at the backside of the cafeteria doors (lower level by bus lane) by the team bus and then head to the away contest. After the away contest concludes, the team bus will make one stop at Comet Field for student drivers to get their vehicles (when an early release from school occurs) and then to the high school for drop-off and pick-up.
